HEALTHY AND SAFETY PERFORMANCE






100% reported that their safety performance had stayed the same over the previous 12 months,

SENIOR LEADERSHIP AND STRATEGY

100% reported that their organisation has identified health and safety as a key priority, yet only 83 feel they are clear about thier organizations' health and safety vision, goals and strategy.

23% report that their CEO invested the necessary resources to promote health and safety within the workplace.

77% feel that the managers within their organization have most of the skills needed to effectively take the lead on health and safety issues.
