
Canadians weigh in on how their workplaces are investing in safety

The survey was distributed via Google Forms and completed by 1510 Canadians in early August 2021.




Safety Performance

Most report that their driver to improve health and safety within the workplace is caring for the wellbeing of others


Employers considered the following metrics a top priortity








Senior Leadership Involvement







Less than a third of senior leadership regularly attended the worksite

Over two thirds surveyed felt that the risks are well known within their workplace






Over one third of employers include health and safety risks
