



Investing in health and safety in the Technology, Media, and **Telecommunications Industries**


HEALTHY AND SAFETY PERFORMANCE



67% reported that their safety performance had improved over the previous 12 months,


68% report that their driver to improve health and safety within the workplace is compliance with legislation and regulations





SENIOR LEADERSHIP AND STRATEGY

100% reported that their organisation has identified health and safety as a key priority, yet 47% feel they are *unclear* about thier organizations' health and safety vision, goals and strategy.



16% feel that the managers within their organization have most of the skills needed to effectively take the lead on health and safety issues.
